Description

Brocky is a beautifully characterful 69ft Replica Bridgewater Tug built by the respected P&J Rickaby in 2002. Combining traditional charm with practical comforts, she offers spacious accommodation for up to five people and has been lovingly maintained throughout. Her interior was freshly repainted in February 2026, while major mechanical works, including a full engine refurbishment and service in September 2025, ensure she is ready to cruise with confidence.

As a vintage-style vessel, Brocky has a handful of minor cosmetic and maintenance jobs remaining, including a bow thruster repair and a few small finishing touches, all of which have been reflected in the attractive asking price.

One of Brocky's standout features is her traditional boatman's cabin, which beautifully captures the heritage of Britain's inland waterways. This cosy space includes a single berth with useful storage beneath, alongside a solid fuel stove that provides both warmth and authentic charm. Cleverly designed storage compartments make excellent use of the available space, creating a practical yet atmospheric retreat that perfectly complements the boat's vintage character.

Separate from the main bathroom, the fully tiled shower room offers a spacious shower enclosure complete with curtain. Modern finishes and quality fittings create a clean and practical space, providing additional convenience for everyday life.

The galley is both practical and full of character, providing everything needed for everyday life afloat. A Sigmaring 250 diesel range forms the heart of the space, supplying cooking facilities while also feeding the central heating system through a back boiler. Under-counter cupboards provide generous storage, while a sink with drainer and 12V fridge complete this well-designed kitchen. The layout offers ample preparation space and blends traditional styling with modern convenience.

The saloon is a welcoming and versatile living space designed for both relaxing and entertaining. A bespoke double sofa bed provides additional sleeping accommodation when required, while vintage cast-iron shelving adds plenty of character and practical storage. Twin side hatches allow natural light and fresh air to flood the cabin, creating a bright and airy atmosphere. A radiator ensures the space remains warm and comfortable throughout the year, while a wall-mounted television completes this inviting lounge.

The forward bedroom offers a peaceful and comfortable owner's cabin with a fixed double bed and generous storage beneath. A roof hatch provides additional natural light and ventilation, while a radiator keeps the cabin cosy during cooler months. A fitted CD player with speakers adds a touch of entertainment, creating a relaxing space to unwind after a day on the water.

The bathroom has been thoughtfully arranged to maximise practicality without compromising comfort. It features a modern composting toilet, wash basin and washing machine within a dedicated utility area, making Brocky particularly well suited for extended cruising. Fully tiled walls and flooring provide a smart, easy-to-maintain finish.

A dedicated electrical and utility room houses the Victron inverter, solar controller, Blue Smart charger and diesel header tank for the domestic heating and cooking system. This area also provides substantial storage, keeping technical equipment neatly organised while offering additional space for cruising essentials.

Brocky is powered by a dependable Isuzu 42hp engine, which underwent a full refurbishment and service in September 2025. The boat is equipped with 12V and 240V electrics, shoreline connection, 350W solar charging, four 110Ah leisure batteries, Victron inverter and smart charger. Hot water is supplied via the engine calorifier, immersion heater and Webasto system, while central heating is provided by the diesel range feeding two radiators.

Offering enormous character, extensive upgrades and excellent liveaboard potential, Brocky represents a wonderful opportunity to own a distinctive Replica Bridgewater Tug that combines heritage styling with the comforts required for modern life on the waterways.
