Welcome aboard Gliding Stream, a charming 50ft traditional stern narrowboat that offers a wonderful opportunity for someone looking to step into the world of inland waterways. Whether you're searching for a comfortable liveaboard, a peaceful weekend retreat, or a capable cruising boat, Gliding Stream provides a solid foundation with plenty of potential to make her your own.

The current owners have happily lived aboard for the past four years while based in Chester, enjoying everything that life on the water has to offer. During their ownership, Gliding Stream has proved to be a comfortable and dependable home. She is now offered for sale as the owners move on to their next adventure, presenting new owners with the chance to continue her story.

While perfectly usable as she is, Gliding Stream is best described as a blank canvas. She would benefit from some cosmetic updating and general TLC, and has been realistically priced to reflect this, making her an excellent opportunity for buyers looking to personalise a boat rather than pay a premium for someone else's tastes.

Stepping aboard from the traditional stern, you enter the dedicated engine room, maintaining the classic feel that traditional narrowboats are so well known for. The heart of the boat is powered by a Kubota Nanni 40hp diesel engine, professionally replaced in July 2021, coupled with a PRM 260 gearbox, offering reassurance and reliability for cruising.

Moving forward into the bedroom, you'll find a generously proportioned space centred around a comfortable king-size cross-bed. Excellent storage has been thoughtfully incorporated throughout, with three wardrobes alongside numerous drawers and cupboards, making the cabin particularly well suited to extended cruising or full-time living.

The bathroom is well equipped and offers more space than many boats of this size. It features a full-size shower, a wash basin set into a vanity unit, a mirrored storage cabinet, cassette toilet and additional storage cupboards, creating a practical and comfortable washroom.

The galley has been designed with functionality in mind and offers everything needed for everyday life aboard. Attractive solid wood worktops complement the traditional Belfast sink with mixer tap, while a 12-volt fridge, four-burner gas hob and full-size integrated Belling oven with separate grill provide excellent cooking facilities. A generous range of cupboards and drawers ensures there is ample storage for provisions, cookware and galley essentials.

At the bow, the spacious saloon provides a welcoming area to relax after a day's cruising. A solid fuel stove creates a cosy focal point during the colder months, supported by a large radiator for additional warmth. Solid wood flooring enhances the traditional feel, while plentiful storage helps keep the living space organised. Glazed doors open directly onto the cratch-covered well deck, allowing natural light to flood the cabin and creating an ideal spot to enjoy a morning coffee or simply watch the waterways drift by.

Built by Triton Narrowboats, Gliding Stream combines a practical layout with generous storage throughout, making excellent use of every inch of her 50-foot length. Her traditional stern configuration will particularly appeal to those who appreciate the heritage and character of classic narrowboats.
