With a hull built in 2007 and launched in 2015, she has enjoyed a careful and thoughtful life on the water. Currently moored at the picturesque Caen Hill Marina just outside Devizes, New Times is perfectly suited for anyone seeking a comfortable liveaboard lifestyle or a relaxing retreat for holidays on the inland waterways.

From new, the hull has been fully epoxied—including the base plate and side plating—providing exceptional long-term protection. In June 2025, she underwent a full reblack, receiving three fresh coats along with new anodes to both the base and sides. Thanks to the epoxy system, no pitting was noted during this work, giving confidence in the condition and integrity of the hull. While regulations require CE marking under the Recreational Craft Regulations, the current owners do not hold this documentation, and prospective buyers are encouraged to seek independent advice regarding any implications.

Stepping aboard, you enter the reverse-layout galley—a beautifully crafted space with handmade bespoke units, a charming Butler's sink, and a fitted cooker. This thoughtful layout not only provides a practical working kitchen but also creates a warm and homely welcome the moment you step inside. Moving forward, the spacious saloon offers a relaxing haven, featuring a multifuel stove with back boiler that brings both warmth and atmosphere to the heart of the boat.

The master bedroom provides a fixed double bed with generous storage beneath, creating a cosy, restful environment. Adjacent is the well-appointed bathroom, complete with a shower, sink with storage, and a newly fitted Porta Potti. At the bow, the second bedroom or office adds remarkable versatility to the boat. With built-in wardrobes, drawers, and a desk, this room is ideal for home working, hobbies, or accommodating guests—and there is ample space to add a double bed if desired.

With a robust hull thickness of 10/6/5/4 and recent updates including a new water pump, shower sump pump, and sink sump pump, New Times is well-equipped for her next chapter. The only outstanding consideration is some roof paintwork still to be completed; the paint has already been purchased, but unfavourable weather has prevented the owners from finishing the job.
