Stepping into the galley, you are greeted by a bright, thoughtfully arranged kitchen space designed to make onboard cooking a pleasure. The Currys Essentials fridge/freezer offers ample cold storage, while the oven and grill with a four-burner gas hob provide all the capability you need for preparing meals on longer journeys. A stainless steel sink with draining board is complemented by generous worktop areas, making food preparation easy and convenient. The starboard side hatch brings in fresh air and natural light, enhancing the ambience of the space. Laminate flooring and plentiful storage cupboards complete this well-equipped and practical galley.

The saloon is a warm, inviting retreat crafted for comfort. Two captain's chairs and a footstool offer an ideal place to unwind with a book or enjoy a cosy evening on the water. A TV is neatly positioned for entertainment, and built-in shelving provides convenient storage for books, décor, and personal items. At the heart of the saloon is a Reflex diesel stove, offering efficient heating and creating a wonderfully snug atmosphere throughout the boat.
